

## **Our Privacy Policy**

INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS, INC. respects the privacy of visitors to our Web sites. This policy describes how and why INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS, INC., its subsidiaries, and affiliate Companies (referred to as "INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS") collect customer information. By voluntarily providing us with information about yourself, you are consenting to its use in accordance with this policy.

### **What Information We Collect**

INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS collects statistical information that *does not* contain personally identifiable information when you visit our Web sites. We use electronic records to compile statistics about how our visitors collectively interact with our Web sites. This data is only used by INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS, technical support staff.

INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS also collects personally identifiable information such as your name, address, telephone number, or e-mail address **only** when you provide it to us. In general, INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS uses this information to process your product order or your request for information about our products.

INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS will not sell or otherwise transfer your personally identifiable information provided through our Web sites to any third parties for their own use unless we disclose to you that we intend to do so.

### **How We Collect Information**

As is common practice, INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS uses a variety of tools to collect Web site user information. In all cases, no personally identifiable information is collected unless you voluntarily agree to do so.

Below is a brief description of the tools used to collect user information:

#### **1. Cookies**

Some INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS Web sites use a technology called "cookies." A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer when you access a Web site. Cookies are capable of storing many types of data and may be used by INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS or a third party for a variety of purposes. For example, some INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS sites utilize cookies in order to eliminate the need of a user to enter a password more than once during visits to one or more of our sites. We also use cookies to help us measure the traffic among our Web sites more accurately by recording the total number of hits received on the INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS Web sites.

Most Web browsers by default are set up to accept cookies. You can, however, reset your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is sent. Note, however, that some portions of our Web sites may not work properly if you refuse to enable cookies.

#### **2. Third Party Analysis**

INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS may collect Web site user information by utilizing other analysis technologies. These analysis technologies are typically provided by third parties. Information collected using these technologies may include the pages you visit on our site, the paths you take within our Web sites, and the length of time that you spend on our Web sites. We use this information in the aggregate for the purpose of understanding how to improve the quality of our Web sites.

#### **3. Web Server Logs**

As is common business practice, INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS Web sites maintain Web server logs. Our Web servers automatically identify your computer by its IP address, and collect that information in its logs. An IP address is a unique number that is assigned to your computer by your Internet Service Provider.

Web server logs can be used to collect statistical data that is generated by your computer when you access an INDIGENE PHARMACEUTICALS Web site, such as the type of Web browser and Operating System used to access the site, the date and time you accessed our site, and the specific Web pages you visited. No personally identifiable information is contained in these Web server logs.

### **How We Use This Information**

Personally identifiable information that we collect is used exclusively by us for internal purposes such as improving our products, learning about our customers' needs, and contacting customers for research, informational, and marketing purposes. Personal identifying information is not shared with other organizations or persons other than to organizations or persons assisting us in the collecting, assembling, or processing of this information or if we are required by law.

Statistical information collected through the use of Cookies, Third Party Analysis, and Web Server Logs is used internally in the aggregate, and does not contain any personally identifying information.
